CITATION

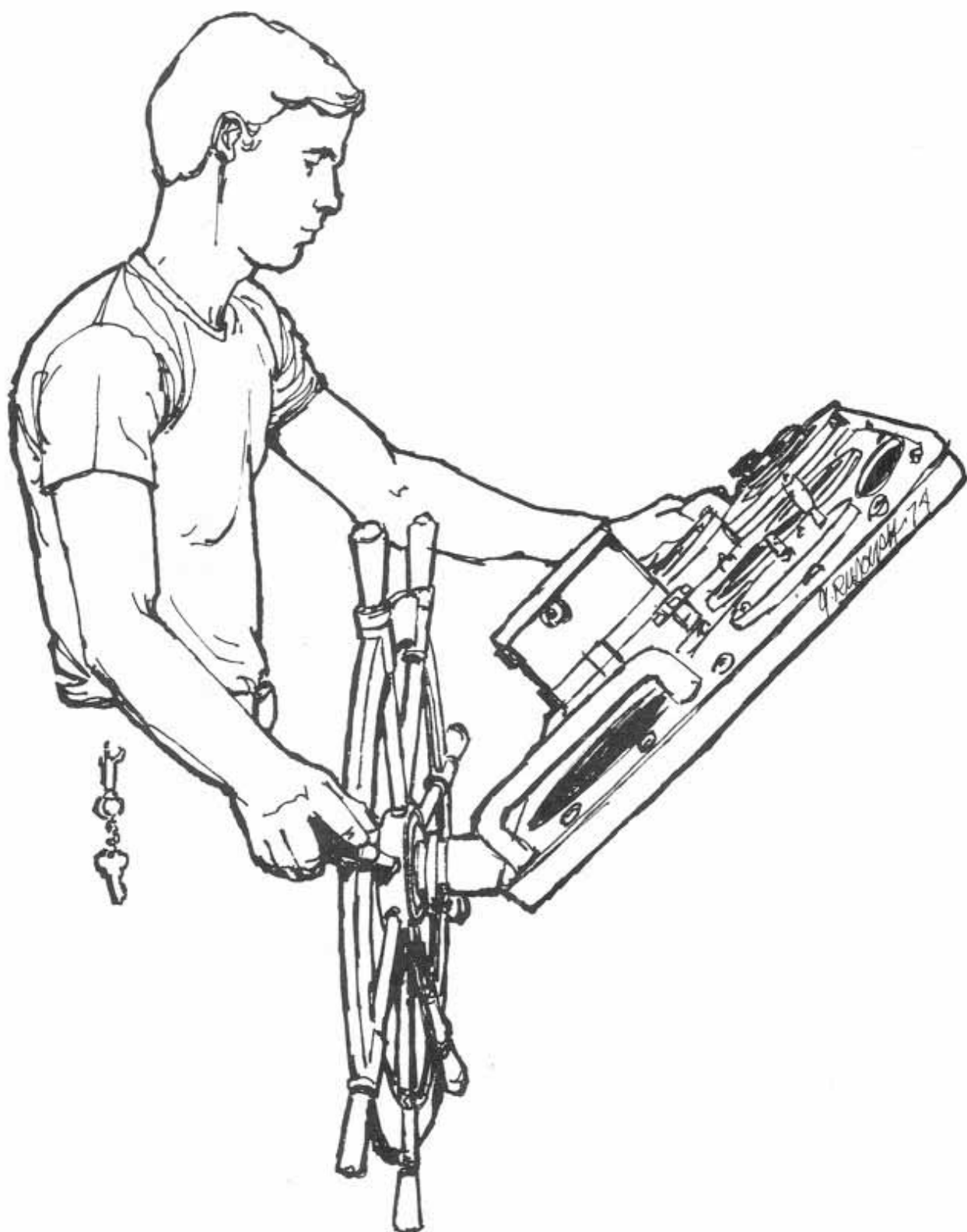
